### **Mental Health Awareness Programme conducted by Vartaman Care Network Foundation**



The Placement Cell of Dr. Rohini Kanta Barua Law College, Dibrugarh, Assam in association with Vartamaan Care Network Foundation organized a workshop on the subject of Mental Health Awareness. The main objective of the event was to enable the students to be free for better careers in the legal profession.
