Intra-College Moot Court Competition



The Moot Court Society of Dr. Rohini Kanta Baruah Law College, Dibrugarh, Assam organized an Intra-College Moot Court Competition on May 20, 2023. The objective of the competition was to inculcate the skills of mootng amongst the college students for preparing a team for inter-college moot competition in the future. The Judges for the competition were Advocate Himanshu Bagaria appointed as an external Judge, Advocate Ajit Bargohain, Advocate R.K. Agarwal, and Mr. Jayanta Boruah (Faculty Coordinator of Moot Court Society) appointed as internal Judges. In total 16 teams participated in the competition. The Moot Court Society of Dr. R.K.B. Law College organized the Dr. Rohini Kanta Barua Memorial National Moot Court Competition (1st Edition), 2024. Around 23 institutions from across India participated in the competition. The Researcher Test was held on February 29, 2024, the Preliminary Rounds were held on March 1st and 2nd, 2024, Quarter Finals were held on March 3rd, 2024 and Semi Finals and Finals were held offline on March 19, 2024. Advocate S. C. Goswami, Advocate Himanshu Bagaria, and Dr. Dipom Baruah, Associate Professor, RGUCOM, were the judges for Semi Finals. Finally, Former Justice Gauhati High Court Biplab Kr. Sarma; Prof. (Dr.) R.C. Barpatragohain, Former Advocate General and Senior Advocate and Sr. Advocate Dibrugarh Bar Association were invited as judges for the Finals.
